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Acne Vulgaris Treatment Guidelines

First-line treatment for severe acne vulgaris includes an oral antibiotic, benzoyl peroxide, and a topical antibiotic (erythromycin or clarithromycin), topical retinoid, or both.

Acne vulgaris is characterized by noninflammatory, open or closed comedones and by inflammatory papules, pustules, and nodules. Acne vulgaris typically affects the areas of skin with the densest population of sebaceous follicles; these areas include the face, the upper part of the chest, and the back.

The treatment regimen your doctor recommends depends on your age, the type and severity of your acne, and what you are willing to commit to. For example, you may need to wash and apply medications to the affected skin twice a day for several weeks.

Oral isotretinoin is recommended for the treatment of severe nodular acne. Other points of note. Oral isotretinoin is appropriate for the treatment of moderate acne that is treatment-resistant or for the management of acne that is producing physical scarring and/or psychosocial distress

Clinical guidelines

Moderate acne only partially responding to treatment and starting to scar and/or causing significant hyperpigmentation (more common in patients with brown or black skin) Patients with associated and severe psychological symptoms, regardless of the physical signs ; Treatment options once referred: Oral isotretinoin (see below)
