### **ICS 239-CG Incident Complexity Analysis (Type 1 and 2)**

The incident type corresponds to both the number of resources required and the anticipated incident duration. The incident types move from Type 5 being the least complex to Type 1 being the most complex. As the number of resources required gets larger and the duration of the incident gets longer, the complexity increases.

### **Incident Complexity**

Training recommendations are now based upon the level of an incident's complexity (Complexity Guide found on pages 16-17 of the NIMS Training Program) that a person may become involved in, from Type 1 to Type 5. Organizations should consider the complexity of incidents that their jurisdictions are most likely to face and tailor the NIMS training for their personnel to meet those needs.

Guidelines to completing the Incident Complexity Analysis: 1) Analyze each element and check the response, Yes or No. 2) If positive responses exceed or are equal to negative responses within any primary factor (A-G), the primary factor should be considered as a positive response.

### **TYPE 1 OR 2 INCIDENT COMPLEXITY ANALYSIS**

Requestor conducts an incident complexity analysis and discusses the results with the provider to identify necessary levels of support; typical incident complexity factors include: a. Threat to life, property, and the environment b.
